A. NON-CONFIDENTIAL FACTS AND ADVICE TO THE PCC

A1. INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

- 1. Introduction
- 1.1 This update provides a summary of the capital expenditure made in 2012/13 to date and the provisional outturn for the full year.
- 2. Overall Position for 2012/13
- 2.1 The revised capital programme for 2012/13 is £12.558m. The provisional outturn for 2012/13 is £8.244m.

- 2.2 The provisional outturn of £8.244m gives an underspend of £4.314m (34%) against the revised budget.
- 2.3 Details of the 2012/13 expenditure are described in section 3 below.
- 2.4 The financing of the 2012/13 capital programme is shown below.

- 2.5 Borrowing over 2012/13 and 2013/14 will be £0.512m less than estimated. This is a result of underspendings not carried forward (£0.461m) and higher than estimated capital receipts (£0.051m).
- 3. Scheme Commentaries:

Building Schemes

- 3.1 £1.356m of the £1.639m programme was spent, a 17% underspending.
- 3.2 It is proposed to carry forward £0.016m for the Boston Custody Upgrade to allow completion of this scheme.

ICT Schemes

- 3.3 The ICT projects were underspent by £0.202m on a programme of £1.179m (17%). There are underspendings on the FCR upgrade of £54k and on the Gainsborough Records management of £39k.
- 3.4 An underspending of £0.010m on the Mobile Data scheme will be carried forward as this is grant funded.

G4S Capital Programme

- 3.5 The contract with G4S includes a programme of business transformation projects which they are responsible for delivering but which are of a capital expenditure nature. In the revised programme these projects amount to £8.643m and the provisional spending is £5.050m.
- 3.6 Given the contractual nature of the projects the underspending of £3.593m is to be carried forward into the 2013/14 capital programme.

Other Schemes

3.7 The vehicle underspending of £0.150m is to be carried forward as this relates to vans which were not delivered by the year end. 3.8 The underspending of £0.084m on body armour replacement is required to be carried forward for updating equipment.

4. 2013/14 Capital Programme

4.1 The schemes proposed to carry forward from the 2012/13 capital programme will be added to the planned programme for 2013/14.
