

Owing to the length of absence, and in order to fulfil all statutory and legal obligations of the Office of Chief Constable during this period, the Chief Constable has recommended the temporary promotion of the Deputy Chief Constable.
2. The Commissioner is invited to confirm the appointment of Deputy Chief Constable Jason Harwin as Temporary Chief Constable of Lincolnshire in the period from 19th September 2019 to 18th October 2019 inclusive.
