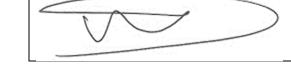

A. NON-CONFIDENTIAL FACTS AND ADVICE TO THE PCC

A1. INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

1. This report sets out changes that are required to the Revenue Budget and Capital Programme 2023/24 and of its financing, and requests authority to partially release certain Earmarked Reserves.

A2. REVENUE BUDGET 2023/24 CHANGES

EMSOU Officers

2. Lincolnshire's Police Officer establishment has increased by 4 FTE, with these posts fully funded by EMSOU. £500k of additional recharge income will be included within Region, with expenditure budgets created within Police Officer Pay (£300k) and Contingency (£200k).

3. Pay Award

Home Office grant funding of £2,745k for the September 2023 pay award was notified post budget setting, this additional income will be included within Specific Grants with expenditure budgets created within Police Officer Pay £2,820k, Police Staff Pay, £1,579k, PCSOs, £85k, Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner, £36k, Victim Services £14k and Finance and Commercial, £27k. In addition to the pay award grant, £1,336k from Pay Awards and £668k from PCC Contingency is to be transferred to support the pay award impact. The surplus income of £188k reduces Reserves Budget Balancing, to fund next year's cost pressure.

Recurrent Funding Requirements

4. £81.5k is required to be transferred from Recurrent Funding Requirements to Digital, Data and Technology in respect to ERP Consultant Fees.

Application of Earmarked Reserves

5. £207k required to be transferred from Application of Earmarked Reserves to Reserves Budget Balancing, as the drawdowns from reserves are no longer required.

A3. TRANSFER TO AND FROM RESERVES

6. Approval is requested for the release of the following funds from earmarked reserves.

Partnerships

7. An amount of £34.563k is to be repurposed and transferred from the Partner Agency Funding reserve to the Revenue Budget reserve as this is no longer required.

8. Excellence in Police Finance

It is proposed that £20k is released from the Excellence in Police Finance reserve to Finance for CIPFA Excellence in Police Finance.

9. PCC & Joint Services

It is proposed that £18k is released from PCC & Joint Services Carry Forward reserve to Finance for additional external audit fees.

Revenue Budget Support

10. It is proposed that £7.4k is released from the Revenue Budget Reserve and transferred to Partnerships for the Think Sharp project.

Performance & Productivity

11. It is proposed that £32k is released from the Performance & Productivity reserve to Police Staff for a SARC Forensic Accreditation post.

A4. CAPITAL PROGRAMME 2023/2024

12. The following change is proposed to the 2023/24 capital programme.

e-Recruitment Applicant Tracking System

13. This system will enable the digital management of the recruitment processes. There is a capital element of £36k and therefore a requirement to increase the capital programme by this amount. This will be funded by the underspend in capital financing through direct revenue financing.
